

MDHHS Response RE: Federal Public Health Emergency Extension

The U.S Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has extended the federal public health emergency. The PHE has been extended for another 90 days effective April 16, 2022, through, July 15, 2022. Please continue to use the COVID-19 Encounter Code Chart ([MDHHS - COVID-19 Encounter Code Chart \(michigan.gov\)](#)) for telemedicine purposes.

Additionally, as a reminder MDHHS's COVID-19 Response policies will remain in effect, including the [MDHHS - COVID-19 Encounter Code Chart \(michigan.gov\)](#), until an appointed time which MDHHS will inform providers of in the future (as indicated in [MSA 20-36](#)). These temporary policies ARE NOT contingent upon the end of the federal PHE and will not be terminated on July 15, even if the federal PHE is not extended. Instead, MDHHS will inform providers of the end dates of those policies using our usual mechanisms for provider communication.
